

Message & Executive Summary

The 2024-2025 Carolina Union Annual Report highlights the following accomplishments to better serve the campus community:

- Increase student engagement.
- Enhance space in the Union for better efficiency and safety.
- Create administrative efficiencies to streamline operations, enhance customer service, and maximize resource utilization.

The Carolina Union staff did an amazing job creating opportunities to increase student engagement through signature programming and innovative approaches.

FallFest, the annual "welcome back to campus" event, attracts over 10,000 students who meet new friends while enjoying free food, giveaways, and activities. Student Life & Leadership (SLL) partnered with the Carolina Union Activities Board (CUAB) to restructure programming that actively engages students rather than simply providing giveaways.

One example was Jubilee, which is an annual concert and festival. Students who attended interacted with other students and enjoyed a concert later that evening. CUAB also attended the National Association for Campus Activities (NACA) conference, which helps them learn how to plan engaging activities.

Event Services planned several Carolina Union Signature Programs, including four Treat Yo' Self events attracting over 1,300 students with themed activities for Halloween, Mental Wellness, and Earth Day. Birthday Bash celebrated the Union's anniversary with close to 800 students. A new signature event, Pepsi in the Pit, provided free Pepsi products to 2,000+ students every Friday.

The Carolina Union has also engaged students in a fun, active learning environment. We hire and train over 150 students to work in the Union. Students attend the Fall Conference, which is a yearly training program that focuses on values development, skill enhancement, safety in the Union, and understanding working roles and responsibilities. The Student Employee Development Committee plans the Fall Conference every year. This committee also revised the student employee evaluation form to better assess student performance and learning while working in the Union. Students are evaluated on values development, resilience, and skill building.

Recognizing that the Carolina Union is an aging facility, we prioritized enhancing space through capital projects and improvements. Major completed projects included a main elevator renovation and HVAC upgrades. The staff also worked on an assessment to identify space to use as a resource room for student organizations. We are also revitalizing the Underground and the Class of 2000 Lounge, which includes new carpeting, lighting, and furniture. A security camera review was conducted to ensure more efficient delivery of service. Future plans include partnering with campus organizations to designate Union spaces for student study and academic programming, creating seamless integration between classroom learning and experiential education opportunities.

The Executive Team worked with staff to identify administrative efficiencies that better serve students through a four-year strategic plan. SLL streamlined the student organization registration process from multiple annual sessions to once yearly. Communications & Creative Services (CCS) began a brand audit to improve Union marketing. Event Services revised reservation policies for events and meetings. The Business & Finance Office relocated to a new suite for better visibility and service to student organizations.

We had a very productive year in the Carolina Union, and I am looking forward to more great opportunities to serve our students.



Accomplishments


- Expanded the creative team by identifying and hiring a skilled student design assistant who brought fresh perspectives to multiple design and marketing projects.
- Revitalized the Carolina Union newsletter with a complete redesign and content refresh that better serves audience needs and interests.
- Launched a strategic brand audit process to assess the Union's current identity and develop recommendations for strengthening brand presence and consistency.

2025-26 Goals

- Finalize the brand audit process and present priority recommendations to ensure consistent, compelling brand representation throughout the Carolina Union.
- Create accessible communication resources including a media messaging guide and toolkit that enables all staff to effectively represent the Union's mission.
- Revamp the student staff structure in CCS through position evaluation, role expansion, and strategic hiring to better serve department needs and student growth.

Mission


The mission of the Event Services office is to connect the Carolina community through exceptional event services and vibrant facilities.

Accomplishments

- Exceeded revenue goal by 28%, providing additional funding that directly supports enhanced programming initiatives and critical building improvements.
- Completed capital projects with the upgrade to the new main elevator for the Union and the replacement of HVAC for the common areas of the East Wing of the facility.
- Recruited and hired the following positions: Associate Director of Event Services, 2 Full-time Event Managers, 2 Part-time Event Specialists, 1 AV Manager, and 1 Part-time Reservation Specialist.
- Restructured Event Services to address budget and staffing needs, eliminating service gaps while creating budget savings.

2025-26 Goals

- Install a new roof on the north wing Union facility.
- Upgrade Union Lounge spaces including the Class of 2000 Lounge, the Underground Lounge, and the Bridge Lounge.
- Hire and recruit new members of the Event Service Team to include Housekeeping Manager, Guest Services Manager, Assistant Maintenance Manager, and Housekeeper.
- Continue space analysis to maximize Union utilization during daytime hours.


Total Occurrences in 2023 - 2024 (Programs/Events/Meetings)



Signature Events Attendance

The Carolina Union's signature events span the academic year. These carefully curated experiences not only enhance student life but also strengthen the bonds that connect generations of Tar Heels. The following attendance data demonstrates the significant impact and reach of our signature events throughout the 2024-2025 academic year.



- 4 dates total with highest participation at the end of each semester.
- Event attendance increased by 11.9% from 2023-24, which can be attributed to consistent programming efforts and enhanced promotional strategies throughout the year..



- 1-day event with heaviest traffic in the afternoon.
- 2024 Birthday bash was a three-day event for the Union's 55th Birthday. Attendance averaged 339 participants per day.
- A 114% increase in attendance from the 2023-24 year can be attributed to consistent programming efforts and enhanced promotional strategies.



- The Pit: 5 occurrences starting in mid-February 2025.
- LDOC Edition: 1-day event

Accomplishments


- Achieved a record 235 applicants for the NC Fellows program (70% increase from 2023-2024).


- Launch a Spring Semester Leadership program.

Through intentional, engaging, and dynamic programming, we aim to turn campus moments into lasting memories.

Accomplishments

- Hosted music festival, Jubilee 2025, in a comeback year for CUAB with an estimated 1,200 attendees.
- Increased the number of committee members by 120 percent.
- Tabled at both the Safetoberfest hosted by Carolina Housing and the UNC School of Law's Summer Resource Fair.

2025-26 Goals

- Create inclusive, student-centered programs that bring together diverse communities, ensuring every student feels welcomed, celebrated, and part of Carolina.
- Develop innovative events that highlight student talent, showcase cultural expression, and reimagine traditional programming in fresh, engaging ways.
- Design programs that promote wellness, inclusivity, and representation, leaving lasting positive memories while responding to the evolving needs of the student body.
- Empower CUAB members to grow as leaders through hands-on planning, while building partnerships across student organizations, departments, and campus communities.

Mission


The Carolina Union creates safe, inclusive and educational experiences that enable students to maximize their time at Carolina.
